Croatian HE system


- Long academic tradition, some universities are among the oldest in South-East Europe
- HEIs are: universities and their constituent units (faculties and arts academies),

lost the right to self-accreditation of study programmes

polytechnics (polytechnics and colleges → transformed to polytechnics)

• Depending on their type of funding: public or private

- 12 universities (9 public and 3 private)
- 34 polytechnics (14 public and 20 private)
- 161,077 students (2020/2021)
- 116 HEIs

- Rectors' Conference (rectors from all public universities → all universities)
- Conference of Polytechnics (Council of Polytechnics and colleges national criteria for job selection of

teachers)

- National Council for Higher Education, Science and Technological Development (15 members)
- Internationalisation; joint study programmes
- Funding; program contracts
- Dismissal of teachers at public HEIs



- Internal QA
 - HEIs and research institutes → Internal QA and enhancement system → unit for QA and enhancement → an annual report.

- External QA \rightarrow ESG, international standards
 - ASHE
 - Quality standards + elements + quality indicators determined by ASHE + public consultation





- shall have the status of a legal person with public authorities
- shall be autonomous and independent in carrying out the activities
- shall comply with the ESG
- shall be periodically evaluated \rightarrow EQAR, ENQA

History

- ASHE was founded in 2005 with the aim of conducting procedures of external evaluation and improving the quality of science and higher education in Croatia.
- The Act on Quality Assurance in Science and Higher Education adopted in 2009 enabled the Agency to achieve its full independence and bring its QA activities into compliance with Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG).
- In accordance with this Act the Agency became the only national body responsible for carrying out external QA activities in higher education and science.
- 2011 externally evaluated ENQA/EQAR membership/full compliance with ESG
- 2016 renewal of ENQA status
- 2017 renewal of EQAR status;
- 2022 renewal of ENQA status;
- 2024 third cycle of external evaluations.





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
ASHE – scope of work

- carry out:
 - external evaluation procedures
 - evaluation of programme contracts;
 - the procedure of recognition and evaluation of foreign HE qualifications;
- encourage the acquisition and expansion of knowledge and research on the system of quality in HE, research and artistic activity in the Republic of Croatia and conduct training of expert panel members participating in EE Procedures;
- gather and process information on the system of HE, research and artistic activity;



- provide information and unify data on the conditions of enrolment in HEIs in Croatia;
- carry out the tasks of cooperation and participation in the international associations and networks;
- carry out evaluation of HEIs and research institutes abroad;
- perform other duties in accordance with other regulations.

External QA activities until 2022 (inclusive)





ASHE Quality Assurance activities

1. INITIAL ACCREDITATION

- of HEI (new or change in the status)
- of research institute (RI, new or change in the status)
 - of study programme

 The accreditation of joint study programmes (the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes)

3. ONE-OFF EVALUATION

- assess one or more areas of activity of a HEI or a research institute

- scope: to take into account petitions or other notifications that point to the need to protect the public interest

2. RE-ACCREDITATION

 mandatory for all public and private HEIs in five-year cycles (third cycle from 2024)


- mandatory for all RI in five-year cycle

- scope: quality assurance (accountability) and quality improvement (enhancement)

4. THEMATIC EVALUATION

- scope: similar evaluation subjects or areas of activity of one or several evaluation subjects
- Evaluates a particular aspect of HEI/RI or the system of HE/science
- Its purpose is the improvement of the evaluated segment of operations of HEI/RI




