### PRACTICAL INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

#### **1. ARRIVAL**

Traveling to Split, one of the most popular coastal destinations in Croatia, can be accomplished through several modes of transport -air travel, public transportation, and private car.

##### *a) BY PLANE (AIRPORT)*

Split Airport is the main international gateway to Croatia's Dalmatian coast. It is located 20 km west of Split, near the town of Trogir. Air travel is by far the fastest and most convenient way to reach Split, especially from distant parts of Europe. The city is served by Split Airport (<https://www.split-airport.hr/>) located a short distance from the urban center. Numerous direct flights connect Split with major European cities such as Vienna, Berlin, Paris, Amsterdam, and Rome.

Airport shuttle bus between the airport and Split is available throughout the day. Timetable and bus stops can be found here: <https://platanus.hr/shuttle-bus-split/>

Taxi services are available near main terminal building during Split Airport operating hours. Uber or Bolt can also be used.

**Participants of the CEENQA Workshop & General Assembly are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from the airport.**

##### *b) BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION*

Public transportation offers long-distance buses, which are the most widely used and accessible. Split is well connected by international bus routes linking it to the cities such as Vienna, Budapest, Prague, and Munich.

Participants can reach Split by bus from Zagreb, the Croatian capital, which itself is connected to other European cities (<https://voznired.akz.hr/?lang=en>)

c) *BY CAR*

Europe's and Croatian well-developed highway network allow for relatively straightforward access to Split from neighbouring countries such as Austria, Slovenia, Hungary, and Italy.
