

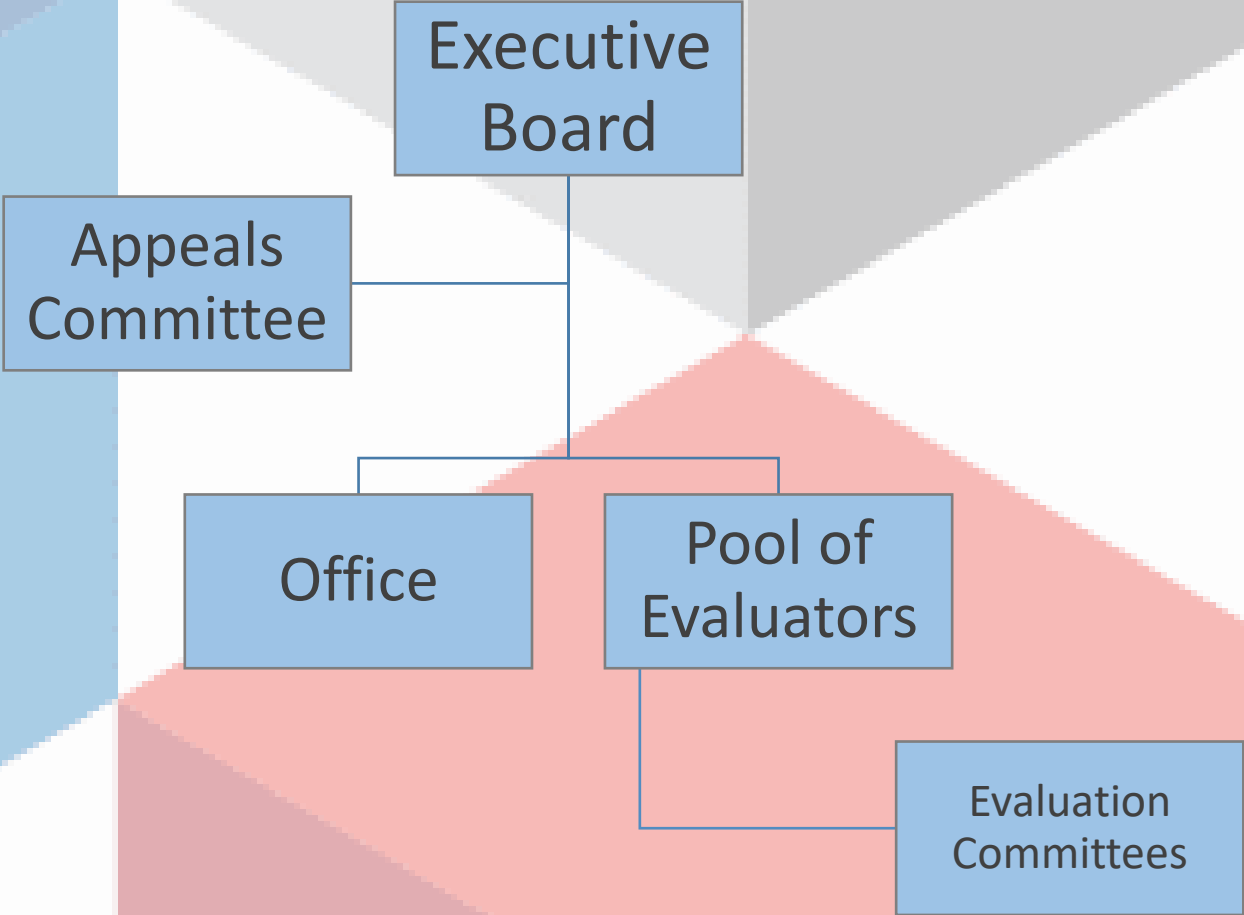

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Piloting of new evaluation methodology I.

- Dual purpose of evaluation for HEIs with institutional accreditation
 - Enhancement
 - Follow-up on institutional accreditation
- Focus of new fit-for-purpose methodology 2023
 - Enhancement-led topics: quality culture, synergy, optimization of programme offer, added value, administrative burden etc.
 - Verification of IQA on a diverse sample of programmes
- Method based on research-type questions
- Multiple site visits: introductory + programme-specific + closing

Piloting of new evaluation methodology II.

- Pilot: Charles University
 - Institutional accreditation 2017 for 10 years
 - 23 fields of study
- Panel of 16 members incl. 4 students
- Timeframe: January 2023 – January 2024
- Site visits: October-November 2023

Programme accreditation and assessment II.

- Assessment guidelines revised
 - Based on development of interpretation of standards and lessons learned from previous assessments
 - Incorporation of recent trends: distance learning etc.
- Turnover in Pool of Evaluators
 - 6 year period of enrollment ending for 1,000 evaluators
 - Re-enrollment campaign in late 2022
- Development of new training
 - Comprehensive brochure incl. case studies
 - Online training sessions with Q&A

WFME Recognition process

- Process initiated in 2022
- Site visit planned for March 2024
- Close cooperation with medical schools (8)

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
