#### SLOVENIAN HIGHER EDUCATION AREA

#### **Higher Education Institutions (HEI)**

- 6 universities (3 public + 3 private) and 1 international association of universities (EMUNI)
- 40 independent higher educational institutions (iHEI)
- 951 study programmes
- o 65.640 students (2018/19)


#### **Higher Vocational Colleges (HVC):**

- o 48 higher vocational colleges 29 state in 19 private
- o 32 study programmes
- 10.056 students (2018/19)
   (data Ministry of Education, Science and Sport)

Study programmes (ISCED-F 2013)



SQAA was established in 2010 as a non-governmental direct budget user and public authorisation holder.

Mission: Development and operation of the quality assurance system in compliance with European QA guidelines.

**Predecessors** (within the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport):

- 1994 The Council for Higher Education of the Republic of Slovenia (established by the Higher Education Act).
- o 2007 Supporting office of the Council is established.



# ORGANISATION OF SQAA

Agency Council (11 members)

## AGENCY COUNCIL

Agency Council is the highest decision-making body of the Agency.

- 3 members nominated by Rectors Conference,
- 1 member nominated by representative association of independent higher education institutions,
- 1 member nominated by representative association of higher vocational colleges,
- 2 members nominated by representative organisation of students in cooperation with the student councils,
- 1 member nominated by representative unions in the higher education area,
- 1 member nominated by representative employers' association,
- 2 members nominated by the Government of the Republic of Slovenia (1 member expert on QA in HE, 1 member working abroad).

11 council members



## AGENCY COUNCIL

- o To appoint and dismiss the Director of the Agency and the members of the Appeal Committee and their deputies.
- To set out the procedures and criteria for external evaluations and accreditations, ECTS and other criteria + criteria for external evaluations of higher vocational colleges.
- To decide on accreditations of HEIs and evaluation of a sample of study programs.
- o To give its consent to the transformation of HEIs.
- o To set out the criteria for entering experts in the register of experts for external evaluations and accreditations.
- o To set out the minimum standards for the appointment of higher education teachers, researchers and faculty assistants at higher education institutions.

- E. EVALUATIONS in case of detected irregulaties



  - 2. the Criteria for Accreditation and External Evaluation by the Council.

# STAKEHOLDERS INVOLEMENT

#### **Communication plan**

- o Monthly newsletter.
- New web site (updates of all procedures).

#### **HEIs involvement**

- o Regular informal visits of HEIs.
- Annual meetings specifically for HEIs (current topics f.e. SE reports).
- Annual conferences on broader subjects.
- Additional external members of agency's selfevaluation group.
- o Follow up procedures after sample evaluation.



# APPEALS AND COMPLAINTS

# 4

#### Before a decision of the Council:

Complaint against group of experts: possible objections from HEIs. Council may appoint different expert.

#### After a decision of the Council: Appeal Committee

- 1. An appeal may be submitted against the decision of the Agency Council in 30 days of its delivery.
- 2. The Appeal Committee decides on the appeal in three months of the submission of the complete appeal. If the appeal is granted, it is returned to the Council for a new decision.
- 3. The decision of the appeal committee may be contested by initiating an administrative dispute.


