Decree No. 907 on December 29,
2019**

42 employees within the Agency



Responsibilities

- Accreditation of educational institutions and programs at all levels;
- Support for the establishment of QA centers;
- Consulting & methodological support;
- Training for QA centers;
- Participation in the licensing of educational institutions;
- Recognition of foreign higher education qualifications;
- Recognition of prior (non-formal and informal) learning.

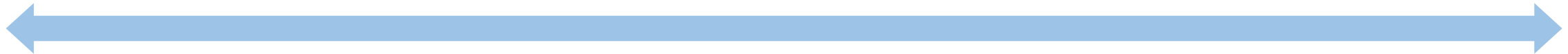

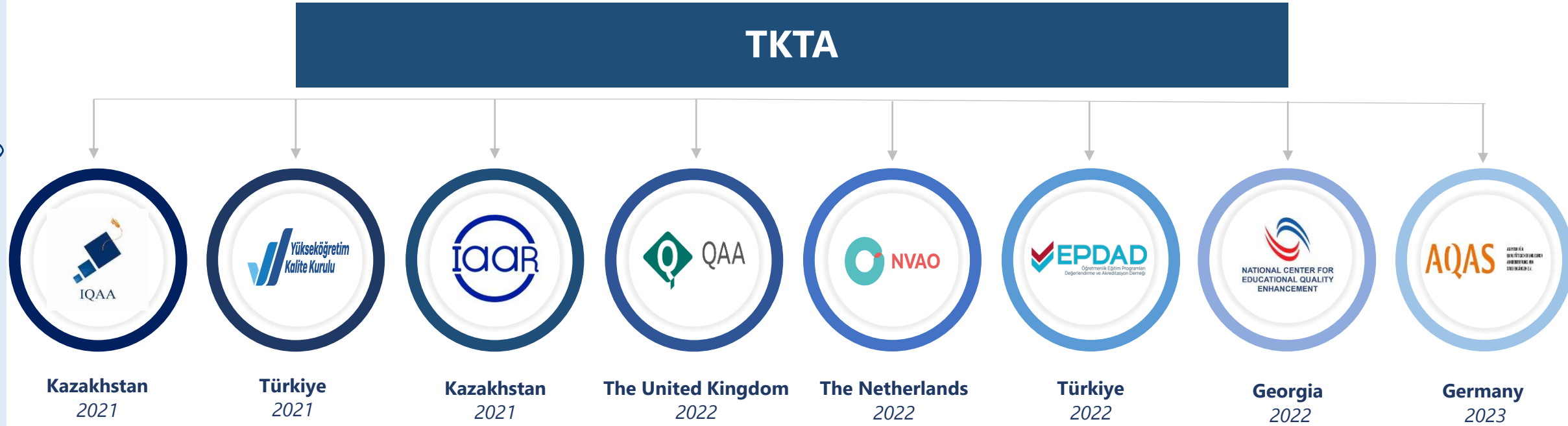

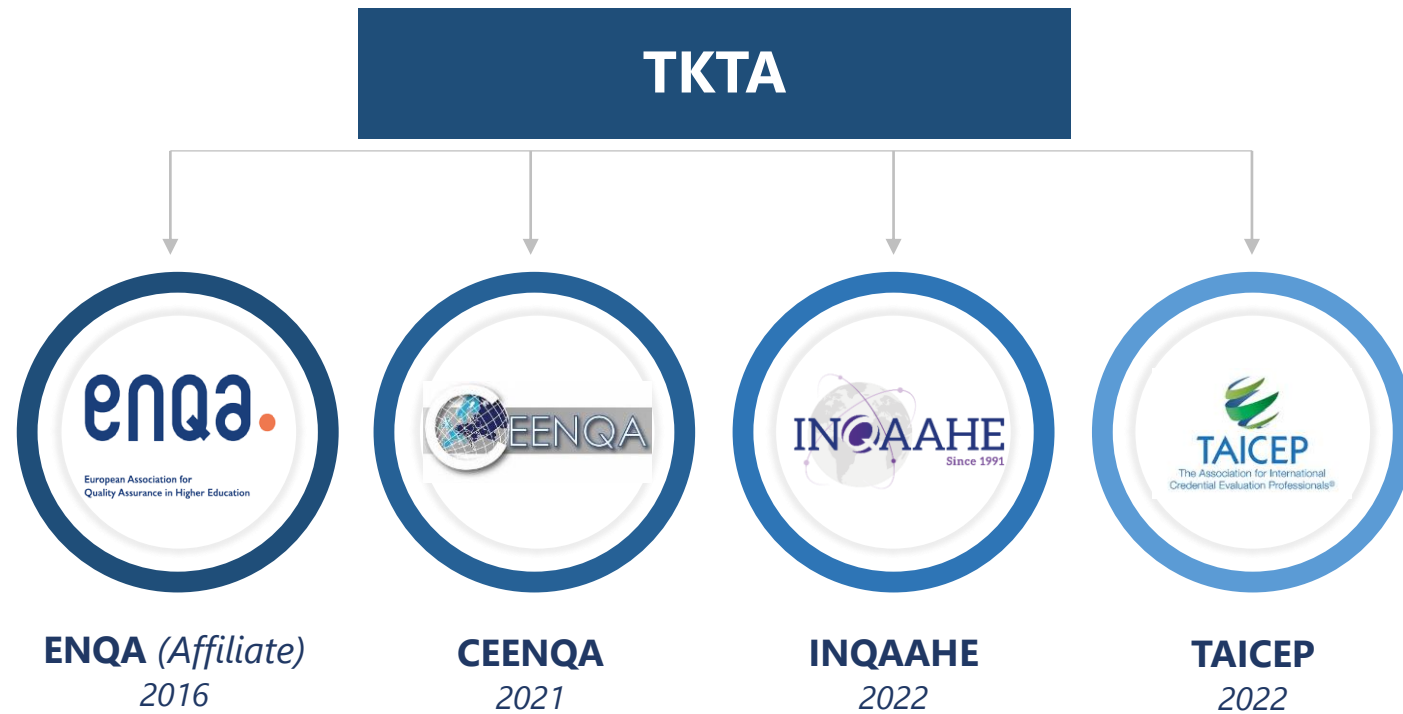
- Assists TKTA in implementation of international standards in QA of higher education;
